



ONGOING SUPPORTS FROM WCSD

- Additional core-aligned resources purchased to support online learning
- Cameras added to all buses for safety/contract tracing measures
- Buses disinfected with ionized sprayer before/after each route
- Recess equipment disinfected before/after each use
- Signage hung throughout school to encourage proper mitigation efforts
- Plastic barriers and safeguards in place during meal times
- PK-4 & 5-12 students enter through separate entrances
- Individualized plans made for immune-compromised students/staff
- Locker room use limited
- Social distancing encouraged throughout the school day
